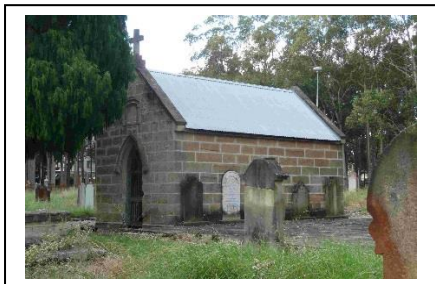

DESCRIPTION: Learn about the man and the many buildings attributed to him in Parramatta



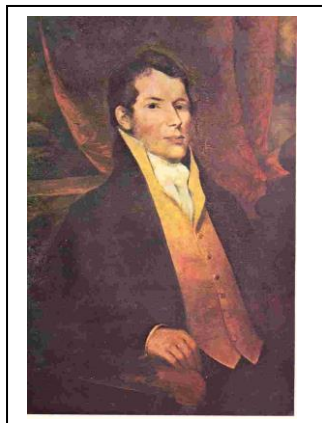
